

MR. T. C. THOMMEN (*Secretary to Government*): The statement is laid on the table.

*Income and expenditure from the Ports.*

279. \*MR. A. EASWARA PILLAI (*Kalkulam II*): Will the Government be pleased to lay on the table a statement showing the income and expenditure for the years 1930 to 1933 from the several ports of the State, each port separately?

MR. PACODE A. NARAYANA PILLAI (*Vilavankod*): May I know whether Government regard this community as unrepresented and backward?

RAO BHADUR N. RAMANUJA AIYANGAR (*Commissioner of Police*): I am not aware of the intentions of Government, Sir.
