(c) the action taken by the Government or the Department with regard to the representation and the application referred to above?

MR. S. SETHA AIYAR : (a) Yes. The Chief Engineer.

(b) Yes, with regard to S. No. 1334.

(c) With regard to the representation for improvements, the Tahsildar has been addressed to ascertain the willingness of the ryots to pay half contribution, and with regard to the application for registry, it was returned to the Tahsildar saying that it can be taken up only after deciding the question of improvements to the tank.

Division Reports.

219. *MR. KOTTALIL P. ABRAHAM (*Muvattupuzha cum Devicolum*) : Will the Government be pleased to state :

(a) who supplies the information to the Land Revenue Commissioner for the Division Reports published by him in the Gazette every week ;

(b) who collects the information in the first instance and on what basis ; and

(c) whether the correctness of the information is checked and verified by any superior authority over the first informant?

MR. K. GEORGE (*Land Revenue and Income Tax Commissioner*) :

(a) The Division Peishkars and the Tahsildars.

(b) The prices of necessaries are collected by the pakuthi and taluk staffs by local enquiry. The rainfall is measured in taluk offices.

MR. K. GEORGE : No. There are mud walls around the market.

MR. S. NILAKANTA PILLAI (*Chirayinkil cum Nedumangad*) : May I know when these mud walls were put up?

MR. K. GEORGE : I am not in a position to say when. By a recent report I learn that the mud walls collapsed during the last rains.
