

*The Madras Preservation of Private Forests

Minister for Food and Forests (Shri K. C. George): Sir, I introduce the Madras Preservation of Private Forests (Amendment) Bill, 1959.

Mr. Speaker: The Bill stands introduced.

The Kerala Agrarian Relations Bill, 1957—(Contd.)

Mr. Speaker: There are some more amendments which have been received in respect of Clause 35. Let them also be moved. After that, you can continue your speech. Now, Mr. M. C. Abraham, you can move your amendments.

Shri M. C. Abraham: Sir, I move.

In clause 35 (1), add the following as a proviso:

“ Provided that on eviction under sub-section (1) a Kudikidappukaran shall be entitled to get the price of the homestead if any erected by him ”.

In clause 35 (3) delete the portion in the first sentence beginning with “Where a person ” and ending with the words “his own residence ” and substitute in their place the following :—

“ the person in possession of land on which there is a homestead in the occupation of the Kudikidappukaran requires such land for the construction of a building for residence of himself or any member of his family or in cases where the Kudikidappukaran commits waste or mischief in respect of the property in which the Kudikidappu is situate ”.

In clause 35(3) in the third sentence, insert the word ‘or panchayat’ after the word ‘municipality’.

Smt K. R. Gouri: Sir, I move.

In clause 35, sub-clause (2), for “ may, require the Kudikidappukaran ” substitute “ may, if he requires the land bona fide for building purposes for himself or for any member of his family, demand the Kudikidappukaran ”.
