I have only attempted to indicate here some of the urgent problems facing this Government and how my Government propose to deal with them. I am sure that your labours and the labours of my Council of Ministers will help the people of this State in finding solutions to the problems of the State.

May I, in the end, wish you once again a year of solid work in the service of the people of Kerala.

After the Speech, the Governor departed from the Assembly Chamber in Procession. The Speaker then resumed the Chair.
