

# Abstract Proceedings of the Travancore Legislative Council.

6<sup>th</sup> March 1891.

The Council resumed its meeting.

Present

It was resolved that section 342 should stand over for consideration.

M.R. Rajaram Row Avezal proposed a new section 341A as follows:-

The Special appellate judge appointed under Our Proclamation dated 22<sup>nd</sup> February 1875 shall hear and dispose of appeals from the decision of our special magistrates and shall reverse their proceedings.

Carried.

The question of bringing in the privilege of Residents' attacks and military sepoy of the British into the Code was brought up by M.R. Rajaram Row Avezal and discussed. Resolved that it was not necessary to provide for it in the Code.

M. Watts moved to omit the words "Sub-committee" addition to the definition of pleader.

Not carried.

M.R. Rajaram Row Avezal proposed to amend the section 41 by defining summary case as meaning a case relating to an offence punishable with fine only if in person.

meant not existing in month or with both  
and a warrant case as meaning any case which is  
not a summary case.

Carried.

M. R. Rajaram Row agreed to enter  
in column 7 of Schedule D appropriate each case  
whether it is a summary or warrant case.
