March 1891

The Council resumed its meeting.

M.R. Shempunoor Boy Anupal proposed an addition to section 5 of the Bill that wherever transportation is mentioned, it shall be read Mutaki Mutandi under section II of 1056.
Carried.

M.R. Rajaraja Rao Anupal proposed an additional clause (12 A) "The appointments of all judges and magistrates under this Code shall be notified in the Government Gazette".
Carried.

M. J. Watts proposed the omission of the words "and he may from time to time make rules consistent with this Code as to the distribution of business among such magistrates" in section 12.
Carried.

Mr. Rajaram Panicker brought to the notice of the Council the remarks of the High Court in regard to the omission of the provision exempting Brahmins and women from capital punishment. He urged it was the High Court who drafted the modification of the custom; he said he thought the Penal and not the Criminal Procedure Code was the place for it. The Council was of opinion that the matter should be taken up when the Bill relating thereto comes up for consideration.

After due consideration it was decided not to adopt the resolution of the Council of the previous day in regard to stating in the Schedule opposite each case whether it is a summons case or warrant case.
