

Abstract Proceedings of the Travancore Legislative Council.

10 March 1897.

The Council resumed its meeting.

Section 116 was discussed but no amendment was proposed. The Council considered the addition made by the High Court was not necessary. Section 181. The provision regarding the suspension of writs and remedies was considered and the Select Committee's suggestion was adopted. Chapter XIV. M. F. Watts moved as an amendment that Chapter XIV be restored as in the British Code and that both the High Court and Select Committee amendments be omitted.

Carried.

Section 181

The addition to section 181 was

discussed and it was resolved to retain the word "of the 1st or 2nd class" as recommended by the Select Committee and as in the British Code.

Section 226. The provision in the last para about compensation a quard public servants was discussed. It was resolved that the High Courts' addition as proposed by the Select Committee be omitted and the section as in the British Code be retained.

M.R. Rajarajam Pillai proposed an amendment viz the omission of summary trials. (Chapter XXII)
Carried.

Section 265. M.R. Rajarajam Pillai proposed to amend this section by cancelling the Select Committee's proposal and restoring the section as it was, but substituting Malayalam for language of the Court.

Section 280. It was also proposed by him that the Select Committee's amendment be omitted.

Carried.
