

Abstract Proceedings of the Travancore Legislative Council.

25 June 1890

The Council met again at the usual place at 3 P.M. this day.

The Bill amending the Arms Regulation was taken up for consideration this day and the discussion continued till the following day, i.e.

26 June 1890.

The Council met again at the usual place at 3 P.M. this day.

The President moved that, as the Arms Regulation II of 1861 is defective in more points than the one proposed to be amended, the Bill brought forward may be dropped and that the mover introduce another Bill dealing with all the necessary amendments.

Resolved accordingly.

In regard to the Bill to amend the Civil Courts Regulation I of 1857 by increasing the small cause jurisdiction of Munsiffs and Judges, M.R. Jayaram Pillai Averal desired a further adjournment to enable him to lay before the Council certain statistics on the point. Adjournment granted.

M.R. C. Pachappa Nairkar Averal moved that the opinions recorded by the judges of the High Court on the subject of the enhancement of jurisdiction be called for from the Government and laid on the table. The majority being in favour of the motion it was passed and the Secretary directed to move the Government for the papers.

M.R. Rajaram Row Averal then moved the introduction of the Bill for adopting the British Indian Evidence Act. M.R. C. Pachappa Nairkar Averal took objection to the form of the Bill proposed to be introduced by him viz:- adopting the British Act Statute.

Mabanadis. The Council concurred with M.R. Raj
Pachappa Nair's proposal and the mover was permitted
to withdraw the Bill with liberty to introduce it in another
form.

M.R. Raj Thambi Pillay also moved for
the introduction of the Bill to regulate the grant of
lands to private individuals for agricultural purposes.
The principle upon which such grants were proposed
he made was "discussed" and with two dissentients
the Bill was introduced and ordered to be published
in the Gazette to be taken into consideration at the
next meeting of the Council.

The introduction of the Bill for re-
gulating the grant of waste lands was adjourned for
the next meeting.

M.R. Raj P. S. Siva Pillay sought applied
for permission to introduce a Bill to regulate and
legalise the Makanadai rights of the Kanyakulam
Manmathavalli Vellalas.

Permission granted.

Mr. J. Watts applied for permission
to introduce a Bill for the protection of game etc.
At this stage this part of the business
was adjourned.
