The Council met again this day.

Section 49 para 2. On M.R. Shan Pillay's motion it was resolved to substitute 'any other' for 'another' in this section. Section 15 clause 2. On the motion of M.R. C. Pachappa Nairker Aungit it was resolved to strike out in the powers of magistrates of the 3<sup>rd</sup> class the power No. 8, namely to order the police to investigate an offence.

Section 174. On the motion of Mr. Watts it was resolved to add the following to section 174 clause 2 "and may specify the court before which the trial is to be held" as the same is in the British Code.

It was resolved in the motion of M.R. Shungra Sobyer Aungit

that the last two clauses of section 526 of the Dutch Criminal Procedure Code be retained, namely

"Every accused person making any such application shall give to the public prosecutor notice in writing of the application together with a copy of the grounds on which it is made and no orders shall be made on the merits of the application unless at least twenty-four hours have elapsed between the giving of such notice and the hearing of such application."

Nothing in this section shall be deemed to affect any order made under section 174

section 259. On the motion of M.Ry. Pachappa Kanchi Avarul, the word "first" in the first line of section 259 was resolved to be omitted as being an error.

M.Ry. P. Thomas Palay proposed to move that the word "ordinary" in four places in Schedule No. III be omitted. Carried.
